Guidelines for Requesting a Specialty

Statement of Purpose

The purpose for holding a Specialty Show under the authority of the Siberian Husky of Canada is to celebrate and promote the Siberian Husky, and to do so in a manner worthy of the name. A specialty show, whether it be a large, flamboyant and expensive affair, or a small, bare-bones event, must meet basic standards as determined by the National Club Standards.

All CKC rules governing Specialty Shows, from the preparation of the premium list, catalogues, to the awarding of ribbons & prizes, shall be adhered to.

The host SHCC area shall ensure that judges and show personnel for the specialty are treated in a manner consistent to those of the all-breed club and the general area.

Procedures

1. The written request, with basic plan & financial statement must be submitted to the National Executive a minimum of 10 months prior to the event.
2. The "plan" should include:
 - a) Independent or with another Club. (if with another Club, the approval letter from other Club to accompany request)
 - b) Venue and all costs that may be associated with that venue, from a per diem to a cost share to no cost. If the venue is in a geographic area other than that of the host SHCC area, then a letter of "approval" from the 2nd SHCC area is to accompany the request.
 - c) Statement re: who is Show Secretary, and Superintendent (i.e. SHCC members or a show service or personnel from the all-breed club). If non-SHCC people are filling these positions, which area member(s) will be responsible to liaise with the official show personnel.
 - d) Classes to be offered: both official & unofficial, including sweeps, parades, and junior handling.
 - e) A budget must be presented.
 - f) A statement regarding any possible impact on the National Specialty.
3. A plan for fundraising to cover all anticipated costs should be included.
